

## Robert and Debra Myrben 68 Cougar

Robert Myrben obtained the '68 Cougar in 2007. His parents (Lee and Billie Myrben, current car club members) purchased it about seven years ago making them the fourth owners. It is a California car containing the original black license plates assigned to the Cougar in 1968. These plates stayed with the car until it was transported to Frisco, Texas when his parents moved there in 2004.



In addition, he has in his possession the car maintenance documentation kept on the car since the first day it was driven off the car lot. When his parents obtained the car, a decision was made to keep it stock, containing the original Ford 302 engine with the four barrel Holly carburetor, and C4 transmission. Since then, the Cougar has had an original vinyl top replaced, new windshield, tires, and a complete body restoration with the original

color applied. Other upgrades have also been the replacements of the brakes, front end bushings, exhaust system, etc. to make it street legal and safe.

Robert started his interest in cars as a teenager by modifying VW bugs and VW vans including body work and repainting.
